ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR A NONSTOCK CORPORATION

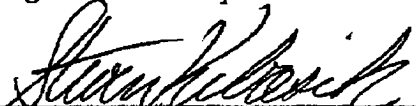
- FIRST: The undersigned, Steven Kubasik, whose address is 2100 Baltimore Road, Rockville, Maryland 20851, being at least eighteen years of age, does hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Maryland.
- SECOND: The name of the corporation is Rockville High School Booster Club, Inc. ✓
- THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:
- The corporation is organized to advance the role extracurricular activities play in the development and well-being of students at Rockville High School. The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. (All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue laws.) In pursuance of these purposes it shall do all things necessary, proper and consistent with maintaining tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3).
- FOURTH: The street address of the principal office of the corporation in Maryland is 2100 Baltimore Road, Rockville, Maryland 20851. ✓
- FIFTH: The name of the registered agent of the corporation in Maryland is Debra S. Munk whose address is 2100 Baltimore Road, Rockville, Maryland 20851 ✓
- SIXTH: The corporation has no authority to issue capital stock.
- SEVENTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be four which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the bylaws of the corporation. The names of the directors who shall act until the first meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are:

Paul Liegey
Monica Welch
Steven Kubasik
- EIGHTH: The internal affairs of the corporation shall be regulated by its Board of Directors as described in the Bylaws. Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes which shall, at the time, qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes

or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

NINTH: No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any director, employee or other individual, partnership, estate, trust or corporation having a personal or private interest in the corporation. Compensation for services actually rendered and reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending to the affairs of this corporation shall be limited to reasonable amounts. No substantial amount of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles or of any Bylaws adopted thereunder, this corporation shall not take any action not permitted by the laws which then apply to this corporation.

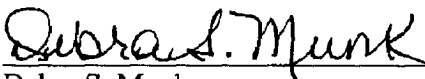
